

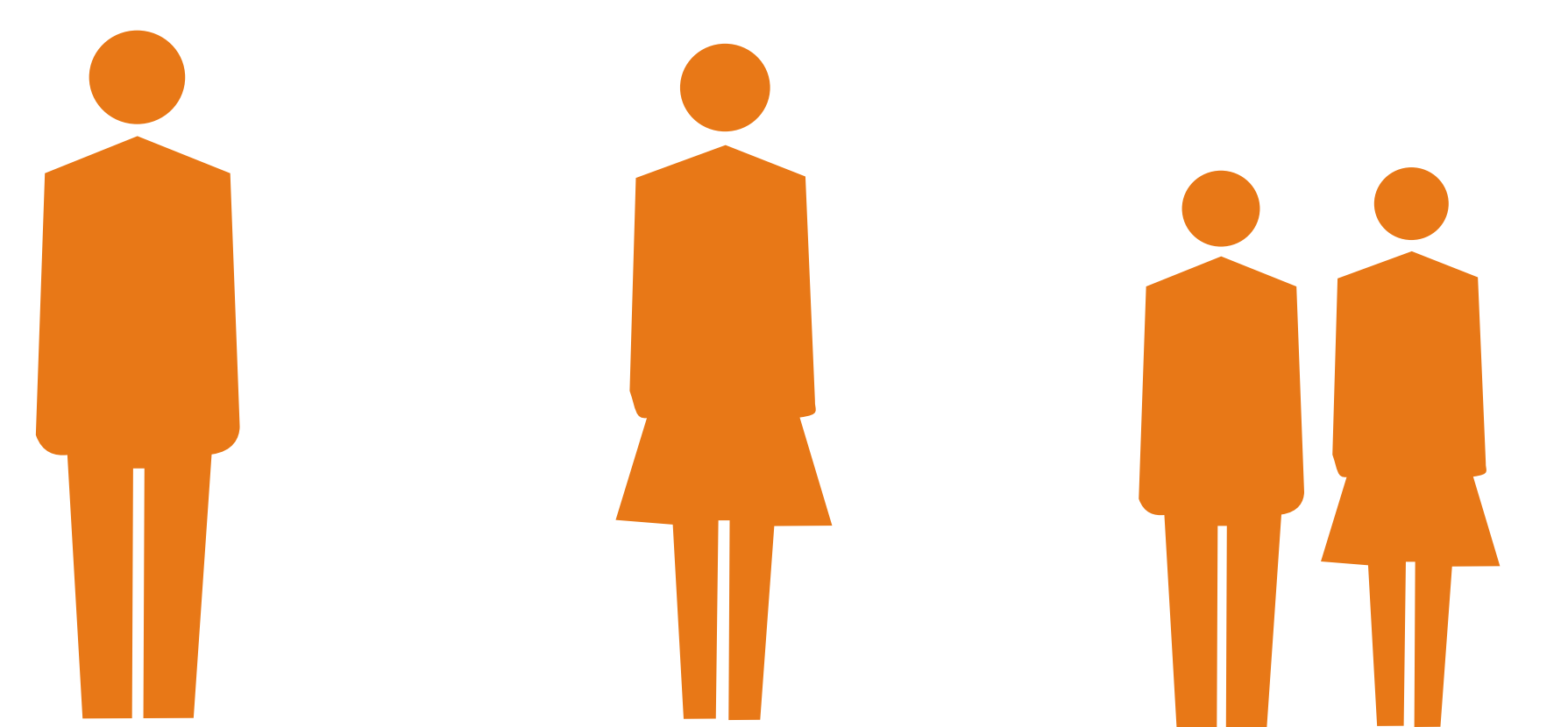

Number of Leprosy Affected people living in the colonies-1644

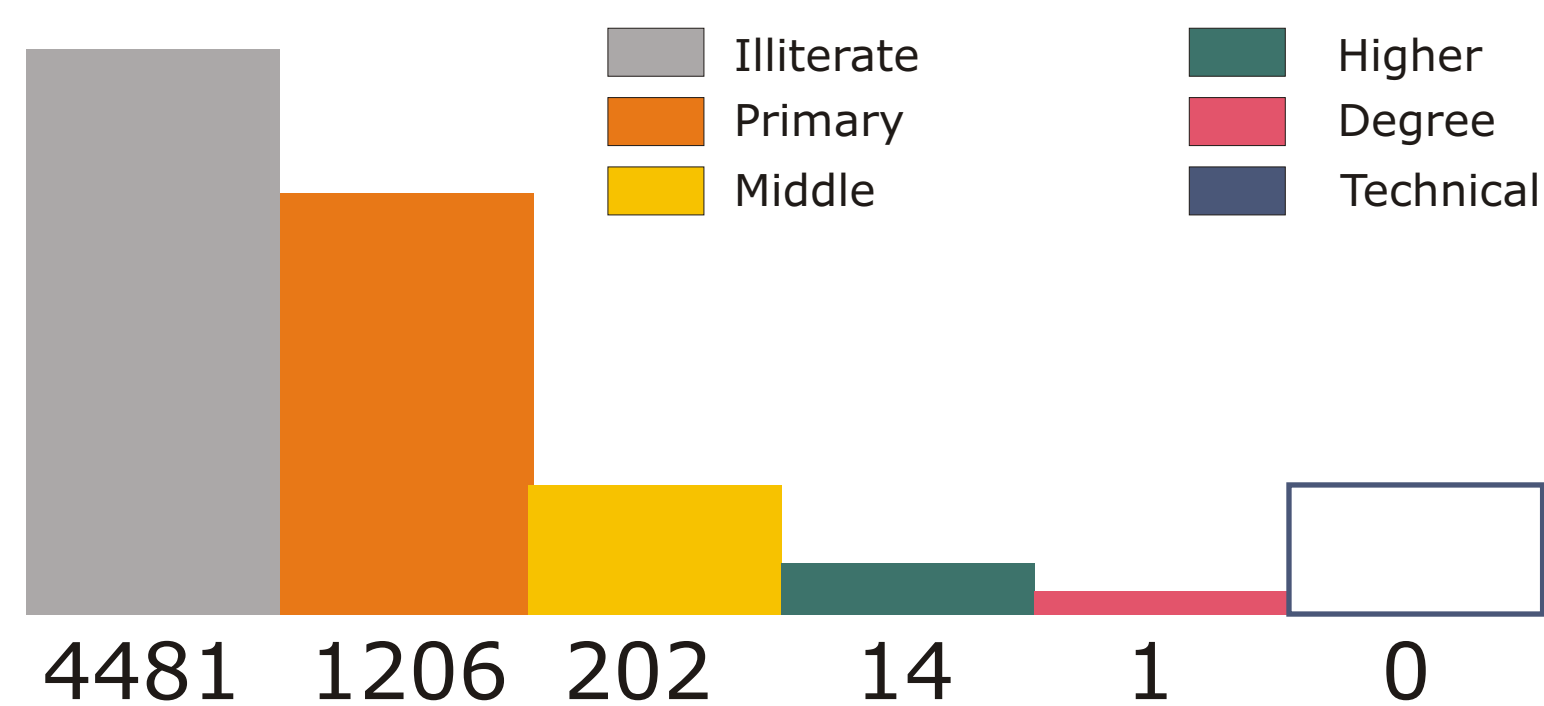


Families living in leprosy colonies

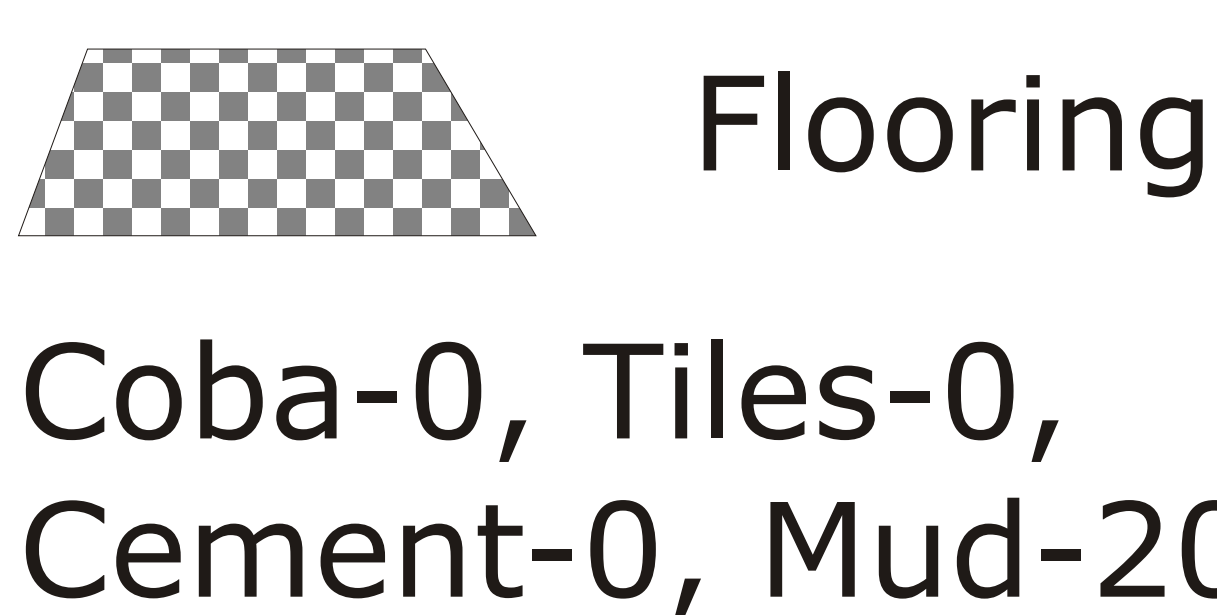
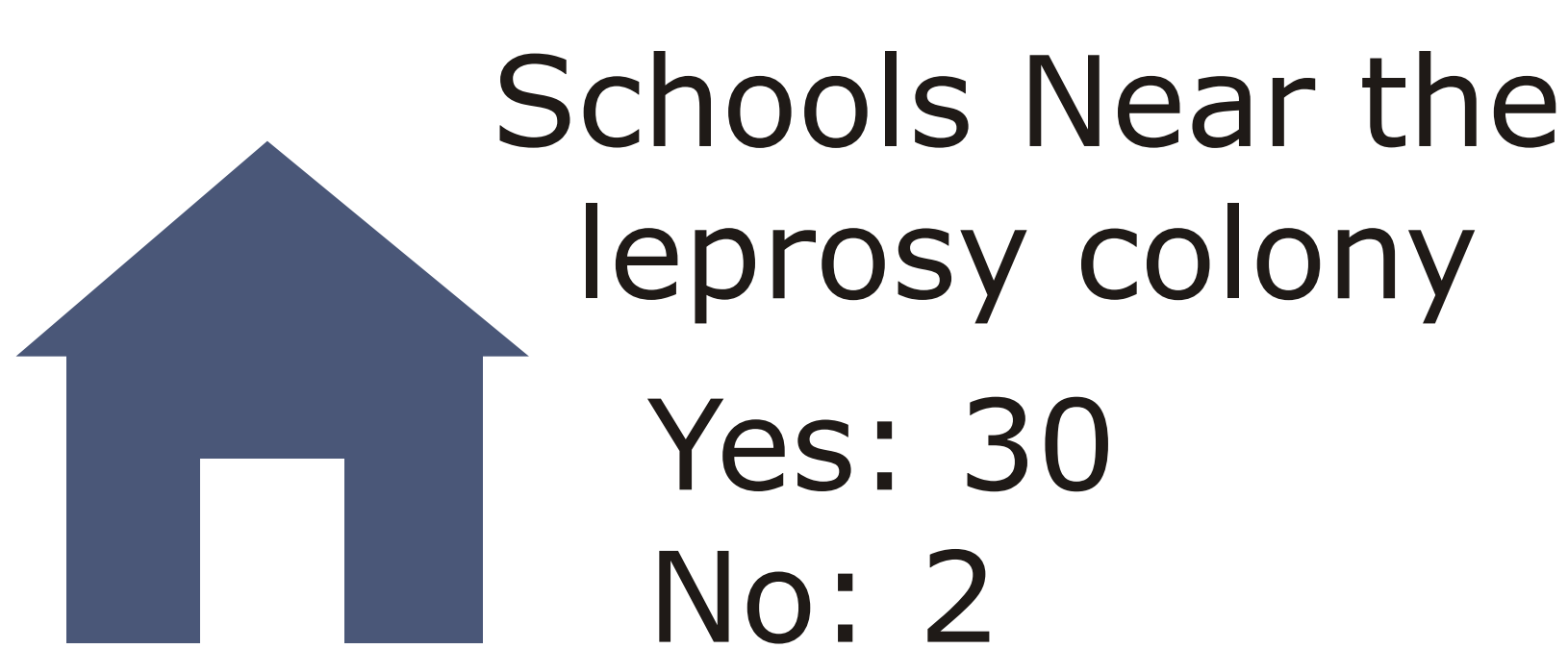


Occupation of people living in leprosy colonies:
